Community Emergency Response Training (CERT)

MORRO BAY, Calif., December 13, 2013–

The Morro Bay Fire Department, the San Luis Obispo County Fire Chief's Association and the Sheriff's Advisory Council are working together to teach you how to help yourself and your neighbors when a large scale disaster strikes. The concept of the 20 hour CERT training is to provide a basic level of expertise in such areas of disaster preparedness, search and rescue procedures, terrorism, disaster medicine, firefighting, and many other related skills. Besides learning to help yourself, CERT training teaches you how to form into effective neighborhood teams, if you so choose, that can greatly assist your neighborhood in overcoming the emergency. In doing so, this training can provide individuals with a sense of self-reliance with an added bonus of neighbors helping neighbors, no matter how overwhelmed the emergency services system might be. Fire Chief Steven Knuckles states, "The reason for you to enroll in the CERT training program is to gain the decision making, organizational, and practical skills you can offer immediate and effective assistance to your family members and neighbors."

Classes start the week of February 10th at the Morro Bay Fire Department, 715 Harbor Street, and are held in the evenings. Since space is limited and sign-ups are on a first come, first served basis, it's important to sign up now.
