

STATE APPROVES COUNTY TO MOVE FURTHER INTO STAGE 2 OF PHASED REOPENING

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR MORRO BAY?

SLO COUNTY REMAINS UNDER THE STATE'S STAY AT HOME ORDER, HOWEVER:

- Restaurants can now provide modified in-restaurant dining.

Note: Per the State's roadmap, breweries, bars, and wineries that do not sell food for sit-down dining are not yet allowed to open at this time.

- Retail stores can now provide in-store shopping.

To reopen, businesses must meet readiness criteria and comply with the County's COVID-19 self-evaluation form which includes:

- Performing a detailed risk assessment and readiness self-evaluation of their business.
- Implementing a site-specific protection plan, including disinfecting protocols and physical distancing guidelines based on business sector guidance. Readiness criteria and information can be found at www.EmergencySLO.org/reopen or e-mail info@morrochamber.org
- Short-term lodging facilities must limit occupancy to no more than 50%. Remember, at this time only essential travel is allowed.*
 - Residential vacation rentals must reduce the number of permitted tenancies per month by 50%*
 - Hotels, Motels, and RV Parks - No more than 1/2 of the facilities rooms may be booked on any day.*

LODGING DIRECTIVES WILL BE ENFORCED BY THE COUNTY
