COMMERCIAL FISHING VESSEL SAFETY EXAMS BECOME MANDATORY

The Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation Act of 2012, requires all commercial fishing vessels, operating beyond 3 nautical miles from shore, have a dockside exam prior to **October 15, 2015**.
