

Harbor Street: Embarcadero to Market Avenue – 2013; Market Avenue to Piney Way – 2017

Marina Street: Embarcadero to Piney Way – 2013

Olive Street: Main Street to Piney Way – 2013

Piney Way: Morro Bay Blvd to Main Street – 2017

Ridgeway: Piney Way to Kern Avenue – 2012

Kings Avenue (Full Depth Reclamation 4” HMA): Ridgeway to Pacific Street – 2013

Quintana Road: Morro Bay Blvd. to South Bay Blvd - 2013

South Bay Blvd (Full Depth Reclamation Lime and Cement soil stabilization with 4” HMA):
Quintana Road to Teresa Drive – 2015

Avalon Street: Main Street to Greenwood Avenue

San Joaquin Street: Main Street to Juniper Avenue – 2015

San Jacinto Street (Bike Lane Improvements): Main Street to Cedar Avenue – 2017

Ironwood Avenue: Elena Avenue to Del Mar Park – 2015
