Written testimony is encouraged so it can be distributed in the Agenda packet to the Commission. Material submitted by the public for Commission review prior to a scheduled hearing should be received by the Planning Division at the Community Development Department, 955 Shasta Avenue, no later than 5:00 P.M. the Tuesday (eight days) prior to the scheduled public hearing. Written testimony provided after the Agenda packet is published will be distributed to the Commission but there may not be enough time to fully consider the information. Mail should be directed to the Community Development Department, Planning Division.

The Brown Act forbids the Commission from taking action or discussing any item not appearing on the agenda, including those items raised at Public Comment. In response to Public Comment, the Commission is limited to:

1. Responding to statements made or questions posed by members of the public; or
2. Requesting staff to report back on a matter at a subsequent meeting; or
3. Directing staff to place the item on a future agenda. (Government Code Section 54954.2(a))

Commission meetings are conducted under the authority of the Chair who may modify the procedures outlined below. The Chair will announce each item. Thereafter, the hearing will be conducted as follows:

1. The Planning Division staff will present the staff report and recommendation on the proposal being heard and respond to questions from Commissioners.
2. The Chair will open the public hearing by first asking the project applicant/agent to present any points necessary for the Commission, as well as the public, to fully understand the proposal.
3. The Chair will then ask other interested persons to present testimony either in support of or in opposition to the proposal.
4. Finally, the Chair may invite the applicant/agent to respond to the public testimony. Thereafter, the Chair will close the public testimony portion of the hearing and limit further discussion to the Commission and staff prior to the Commission taking action on a decision.

## **APPEALS**

If you are dissatisfied with an approval or denial of a project, you have the right to appeal this decision to the City Council up to 10 calendar days after the date of action. Pursuant to Government Code §65009, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Commission, at, or prior to, the public hearing. The appeal form is available at the Community Development Department and on the City's web site. If legitimate coastal resource issues related to our Local Coastal Program are raised in the appeal, there is no fee if the subject property is located within the Coastal Appeal Area. If the property is located outside the Coastal Appeal Area, the fee is a \$277 flat fee. If a fee is required, the appeal will not be considered complete if the fee is not paid. If the City decides in the appellant's favor then the fee will be refunded.

City Council decisions may also be appealed to the California Coastal Commission pursuant to the Coastal Act Section 30603 for those projects that are in their appeals jurisdiction. Exhaustion of appeals at the City is required prior to appealing the matter to the California Coastal Commission. The appeal to the City Council must be made to the City and the appeal to the California Coastal Commission must be made directly to the California Coastal Commission Office. These regulations provide the California Coastal Commission 10 working days following the expiration of the City appeal period to appeal the decision. This means that no construction permit shall be issued until both the City and Coastal Commission appeal period have expired without an appeal being filed. **ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:**

The project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act under Class 3, Section 15303(b) for the construction of a multi-family residential structure under four units. Additionally, none of the Categorical Exemption exceptions, noted under Section 15300.2, apply to the project.

**PROJECT DISCUSSION:**

The proposed duplex residence with one 2,212 sf unit and one 2,426 sf unit at 396 Hill was administratively approved on May 8, 2017. The approval was valid for two years or until May 2019. Requests for a one-year administrative extension were approved in 2019 and 2020 per MBMC 17.60.140 with Director approval. Municipal Code requirements only allow for two administrative extensions of a planning permit. After that, planning permit extensions are only allowed with Planning Commission approval.

The permittee, Mr. Godfrey, submitted a request for permit extension on May 3, 2021 (See Exhibit B). He is requesting a one-year extension due to hardships caused by

the COVID-19 pandemic and property ownership changes. Mr. Godfrey purchased the property in February of 2020 with intention to be under construction before now. However, due to the coronavirus pandemic, building permit submittal was delayed due to engineering business shutdowns in 2020. In addition, after purchasing the property, a minor amendment to the plans was approved by staff related to floor plan and exterior design changes (MIN21-002).

Mr. Godfrey has been in frequent contact with staff regarding timelines and the permit modification application. He has shown a good-faith effort to comply with the original permit deadlines. Construction and permit processing delays associated with the coronavirus pandemic are not uncommon and when they arise Staff seeks to work with the applicants to move projects forward. Therefore, staff is in support of the request and recommends that the Planning Commission authorize a one-year extension. The permittee applied for a building permit on March 18, 2021. The building plans are under review, and a comment letter was sent to the applicant on May 13, 2021. Mr. Godfrey is eager to build and has been actively pursuing permit approval, so we anticipate that the one-year extension should be adequate to allow Mr. Godfrey to start construction and therefore inaugurate the permit. All conditions of approval would remain on the project.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission approve a 1-year extension.

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission of the City of Morro Bay (the "City") conducted a public hearing via video conference on June 1, 2021 for the purpose of considering a time extension of Coastal Development Permit CP0-515 and Minor Use Permit UP0-45, which was approved on May 8, 2017 for new construction of a duplex residence with one 2,212 sf unit and one 2,426 sf unit with garages on a vacant lot ("Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Morro Bay issued an administrative Coastal Development and Minor Use Permit for construction of a new duplex at 396 Hill Street on May 8, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Morro Bay Municipal Code section 17.60.140, the Community Development Director authorized two one-year extensions in 2019 and 2020 and no further extensions may be approved without Planning Commission approval; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20 issued on March 17, 2020 in response to the present State of Emergency in existence due to the threat of COVID-19, the City of Morro Bay Planning Commission is authorized to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and all requirements in the Brown Act expressly or impliedly requiring the physical presence of members, the clerk or other personnel of the body, or of the public as a condition of participation in or quorum for a public meeting are hereby waived; and

**WHEREAS**, notices of the public hearings were provided at the time and in the manner required by law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission has duly considered all evidence, including the testimony of the applicant, interested parties, and the evaluation and recommendations by staff, presented at said hearing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Planning Commission of the City of Morro Bay as follows:

**Section 1: Findings.** Based upon all the evidence, the Commission makes the following findings:

# EXHIBIT A

## California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Finding

1. That the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act, under Class 3, Section 15303(b) for New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, which allows for the development of a duplex or similar multi-family residential structure, totaling no more than four dwelling units. Additionally, none of the Categorical Exemption exceptions, noted under Section 15300.2, apply to the project.

## Coastal Development Permit Findings

1. The Planning Commission finds that the project is consistent with applicable provisions of the Local Coastal Program and the General Plan for the City of Morro Bay for new construction of a duplex residence on a vacant lot in the MCR/R-4/SP Mixed Commercial and Residential Zoning District.
2. The Planning Commission finds the project, as conditioned, is consistent with the character of the neighborhood in which it is located. It is surrounded by compatible uses of low density residential development; has similar bulk and scale as nearby structures.

## Minor Use Permit Findings

1. The project will not be detrimental to the health, safety, comfort, and general welfare of the persons residing or working in the neighborhood because the project conforms to all pertinent development and performance standards as set forth in the Zoning Ordinance.
2. The project will not be injurious or detrimental to property and improvements in the neighborhood or the general welfare of the City because, as conditioned, the residential project is consistent with the provisions set forth in the Local Coastal Program, the General Plan, and all pertinent Sections of the Morro Bay Municipal Code.

## North Main Specific Plan Findings

1. The development standards of the North Main Street Specific Plan have been met for this project in that the proposed project of a new two-unit multi-family residential development in that the structure shall not exceed the 25' height limit and the vacant parcel does not contain any existing mature trees.

**Section 2. Action.** The Planning Commission does hereby approve a time extension of 1 year for Coastal Development Permit CP0-515 and Minor Use Permit UP0-455 for property located at 396 Hill Street subject to the following conditions:

Any changes to this approved permit determined, by the Manager, not to be minor shall require the filing of an application for a permit amendment subject to Planning Commission review.
3. Compliance with the Law: (a) All requirements of any law, ordinance or regulation of the State of California, the City, and any other governmental entity shall be complied with in the exercise of this approval, (b) This project shall meet all applicable requirements under the MBMC and shall be consistent with all programs and policies contained in the LCP and General Plan for the City.
4. Hold Harmless: The applicant, as a condition of approval, hereby agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City, its agents, officers, and employees, from any claim, action, or proceeding against the City as a result of the action or inaction by the City, or from any claim to attack, set aside, void, or annul this approval by the City of the applicant's project; or Applicant's failure to comply with conditions of approval. Applicant understands and acknowledges the City is under no obligation to defend any legal actions challenging the City's actions with respect to the project. This condition and agreement shall be binding on all successors and assigns.
5. Compliance with Conditions: The applicant's establishment of the use or development of the subject property constitutes acknowledgement and acceptance of all Conditions of Approval. Compliance with and execution of all conditions listed hereon shall be required prior to obtaining final building inspection clearance. Deviation from this requirement shall be permitted only by written consent of the Manager or as authorized by the Planning Commission. Failure to comply with any of these conditions shall render this entitlement, at the discretion of the Manager, null and void. Continuation of the use without a valid entitlement will constitute a violation of the MBMC and is a misdemeanor.

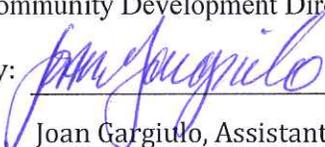

## **I. FINDINGS OF APPROVAL**

The Community Development Director has reviewed this Coastal Development Permit and Minor Use Permit application and finds the following:

### California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

1. The project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act, under Class 3, Section 15303(b) for New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures which allows for the development of a duplex or similar multi-family residential structure, totaling no more than four dwelling units. Additionally, none of the Categorical Exemption exception, noted under Section 15300.2 apply to the project.

### Coastal Development Permit findings

2. That the project is the construction of a two-unit multi-family structure on a 5,000 sq. ft. parcel. Specifically, unit A includes 1,745 sq. ft. of habitable floor area and a 540 sq. ft. garage. Unit B includes 1,517 sq. ft. of habitable floor area, a 552 sq. ft. garage, and a 775 sq. ft. playroom. The project is located within the MCR/R-4/SP Mixed Commercial and Residential Zoning District, therefore the multi-family residential development is consistent with the applicable provisions of the Certified Local Coastal Program (LCP) and the General Plan for the City of Morro Bay.

### Minor Use Permit Findings

1. The project will not be detrimental to the health, safety, comfort and general welfare of the persons residing or working in the neighborhood, because the project conforms to all pertinent development and performance standards as set forth in the Zoning Ordinance.
2. The project will not be injurious or detrimental to property and improvements in the neighborhood or the general welfare of the City because as conditioned the residential project is consistent with the provisions set forth in the Local Coastal Program, the General Plan, and all pertinent Sections of the Morro Bay Municipal Code.

### North Main Specific Plan Findings

1. The development standards of the North Main Street specific plan have been met for this project in that the proposed project of a new two-unit multi-family residential development in that the structure shall not exceed the 25 ft. height limit and the vacant parcel does not contain any existing mature trees.

## II. CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

### STANDARD CONDITIONS:

1. Permit: This permit is granted for the land described on Assessor Parcel Number 068-282-032 and plans received by the City on March 14, 2017 and on file with the Community Development Department.
2. Inaugurate Within Two Year: Unless the construction or operation of the structure, facility, or use is commenced not later than two (2) years after the effective date of this approval and is diligently pursued thereafter, this approval will automatically become null and void; provided, however, that upon the written request of the applicant, prior to the expiration of this approval, the applicant may request up to two extensions for not more than one (1) additional year each. Said extensions may be granted by the Director, upon finding that the project complies with all applicable provisions of the Morro Bay Municipal Code, General Plan and Local Coastal Program Land Use Plan (LCP) in effect at the time of the extension request.
3. Changes: Any minor change may be approved by the Community Development Director. Any substantial change will require the filing of an application for an amendment.
4. Compliance with the Law: All requirements of any law, ordinance or regulation of the State of California, City of Morro Bay, and any other governmental entity shall be complied with in the exercise of this approval.
5. Hold Harmless: The applicant, as a condition of approval, hereby agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City, its agents, officers, and employees, from any claim, action, or proceeding against the City as a result of the action or inaction by the City, or from any claim to attack, set aside, void, or annul this approval by the City of the applicant's project; or applicant's failure to comply with conditions of approval. This condition and agreement shall be binding on all successors and assigns.
6. Compliance with Conditions: Compliance with and execution of all conditions listed hereon shall be necessary, unless otherwise specified, prior to obtaining final building inspection clearance. Deviation from this requirement shall be permitted only by written consent of the Planning and Building Director and/or as authorized by the Planning Commission. Failure to comply with these conditions shall render this entitlement, at the discretion of the Director, null and void. Continuation of the use without a valid entitlement will constitute a violation of the Morro Bay Municipal Code and is a misdemeanor.
7. Archaeology: In the event of the unforeseen encounter of subsurface materials suspected to be of an archaeological or paleontological nature, all grading or excavation shall immediately cease in the immediate area, and the find should be left untouched until a qualified professional archaeologist or paleontologist, whichever is appropriate, is contacted and called in to evaluate and make recommendations as to disposition, mitigation and/or salvage. The developer shall be liable for costs associated with the professional investigation.
8. Compliance with Morro Bay Standards: This project shall meet all applicable requirements under the Morro Bay Municipal Code, and shall be consistent with all programs and policies contained in the certified Coastal Land Use plan and General Plan for the City of Morro Bay.

## PLANNING CONDITIONS:

1. CEQA Exemption: If the applicant elects to post the Categorical Exemption with the County Clerk's Office then a required fee of \$50 fee shall be made payable to "County of San Luis Obispo" and delivered to the County Clerk along with the Categorical Exemption form attached to the coastal development permit. This filing has the effect of starting a 35-day statute of limitations period for challenges to the decision in place of the 180-day period otherwise in effect.
2. Construction Hours: Pursuant to section 9.28.030.I, Construction or Repairing of Buildings. The erection (including excavating), demolition, alteration or repair of any building or general land grading and contour activity using equipment in such a manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of fifty feet from the building other than between the hours of seven a.m. and seven p.m. on weekdays and eight a.m. and seven p.m. on weekends except in case of urgent necessity in the interest of public health and safety, and then only with a permit from the community development department, which permit may be granted for a period not to exceed three days or less while the emergency continues and which permit may be renewed for a period of three days or less while the emergency continues.
3. Dust Control: That prior to issuance of any grading permit, a method of control to prevent dust and windblown earth problems shall be submitted for review and approval by the Building Official.
4. Boundaries and Setbacks: The property owner is responsible for verification of lot boundaries. Storage containers or other equipment shall not encroach into the required setback areas consistent with the zoning district.
5. Conditions of Approval on Building Plans: Prior to the issuance of a Building Permit, the final Conditions of Approval shall be attached to the set of approved plans. The sheet containing Conditions of Approval shall be the same size as other plan sheets and shall be the last sheet in the set of Building Plans.
6. Landscaping in Front Setback: A minimum of five feet of landscaped area shall be provided within the front setback area on either side of the driveway.
7. Landscaping: All side and rear setback areas shall be landscaped.
8. Lighting: Any site lighting proposed shall be shielded and downward facing to ensure compatibility with the adjacent residential neighborhood.

## BUILDING CONDITIONS:

1. Building Permit: Prior to construction, the applicant shall submit a complete Building Permit Application and obtain the required Building permit.

## FIRE DEPARTMENT CONDITIONS:

1. Automatic fire sprinklers. An automatic fire sprinkler system, in accordance with NFPA 13-D, California Fire Code (Section 903), California Residential Code (Section R313), and Morro Bay Municipal Code (Section 14.08.090(L)(1)) is required.

Applicant shall submit plans for an automatic fire sprinkler system, in accordance with NFPA 13-D, to Morro Bay Community Development Department for review.

2. Carbon monoxide alarms in new dwellings and sleeping units. An approved carbon monoxide alarm shall be installed in dwellings having a fossil fuel-burning heater or appliance, fireplace or an attached garage. Carbon monoxide alarms shall be listed as complying with UL 2034 and be installed and maintained in accordance with NFPA 720 and the manufacturer's instructions. (CRC R315.2)

Applicant shall provide Carbon Monoxide detection in accordance with CRC R315.2.

3. Fire Safety During Construction and Demolition shall be in accordance with 2016 California Fire Code, Chapter 33. This chapter prescribes minimum safeguards for construction, alteration and demolition operations to provide reasonable safety to life and property from fire during such operations

Applicant shall include above language on Building Plan submittal.

## **PUBLIC WORKS CONDITIONS:**

1. Stormwater Management: The City has adopted Low Impact Development (LID) and Post Construction requirements to protect water quality and control runoff flow from new and redevelopment projects. The requirements can be found in the Stormwater management guidance manual on the City's website [www.morro-bay.ca.us/mainmanual](http://www.morro-bay.ca.us/mainmanual) Projects with more than 2,500sf of new or redeveloped impervious area are subject to these requirements.
2. Frontage Improvements: This lot is in the R-4 Zoning district and the installation of frontage improvements is required. Show the installation of a City standard driveway approach B-6, sidewalk, curb and street tree. If permeable pavers are to be used, a modified driveway approach with a 12" wide PCC grade beam should be constructed to stabilize the front edge of the pavers.
3. Sewer & Public Utility Easement: Verify if neighboring property (398 Hill Street) has a sewer lateral going through property in order to connect to sewer mainline within 3 foot utility easement. Our records indicate there are three sewer laterals connecting off this sewer mainline. The first sewer lateral connection is approximately 12 feet from the manhole off Hill Street. The second lateral connection is approximately 22.3 feet from the manhole and the third lateral connection is approximately 74.6 feet from the manhole.
4. Sewer Lateral: If an existing lateral is used, perform a video inspection of the lateral and submit to Public Works via flash drive or DVD, prior to building permit issuance. Lateral shall be repaired as necessary and all repairs shall be noted on approved set of plans. If a new lateral is being proposed and old lateral exists, include a note on the plans to cap and abandon existing sewer lateral.
5. Erosion and Sediment Control Plan: For small projects less than one acre and less than 15% slope, provide a standard erosion and sediment control plan. The Plan shall show

control measures to provide protection against erosion of adjacent property and prevent sediment or debris from entering the City right of way, adjacent properties, any harbor, waterway, or ecologically sensitive area.

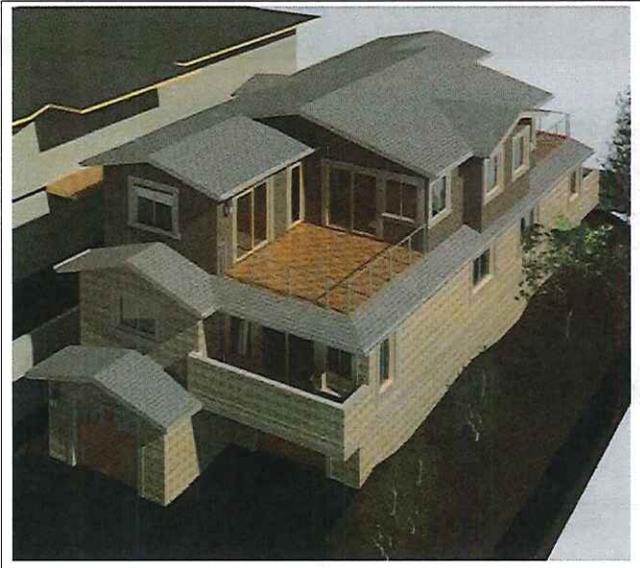

Water Meter: Per Resolution No. 06-16, all new water allocations requested for 2016 shall be offset on a two-to-one basis (or 440 gallons per day) by providing retrofits to existing uses or providing non-required water savings features for development that would benefit from water allocation. Submit a list of items and supporting documents (such as manufacturer's specifications, manufacturer's water calculations, WELO Water calculations, etc.) proving water savings amount. See attached "Water Allocation Form". The Public Works Director is responsible for the review and approval of the proposed retrofits to ensure they offset the water supply requested by new development. Retrofits may include, but are not limited to, any of the following water savings best management practices:
  - Irrigation retrofits
  - Waterless urinals

  - Ultra-Low flow toilets

7. Encroachment Permits: A standard encroachment permit shall be required for the proposed driveway; the driveway shall comply with B-9 (Driveway Ramps: Size & Location). A sewer encroachment permit shall be required for any repairs or installation of a sewer lateral. When utility connections require pavement cuts a traffic control plan indicating appropriate signing, marking, barricades and flaggers must be submitted with the Encroachment Permit application.

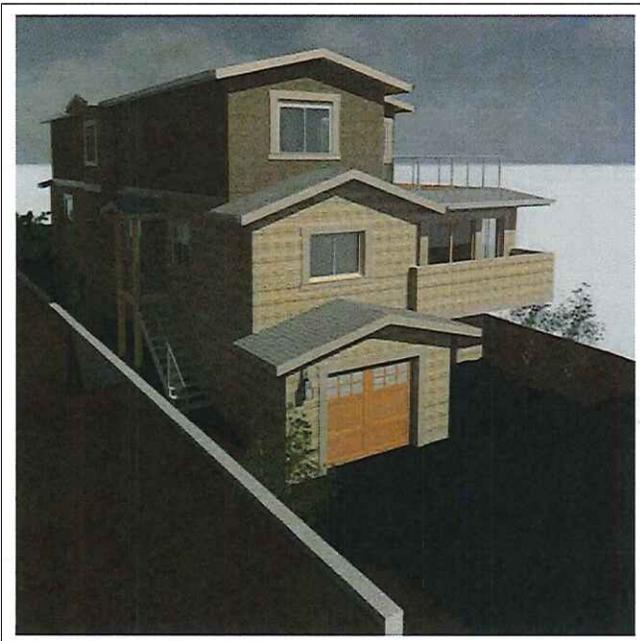

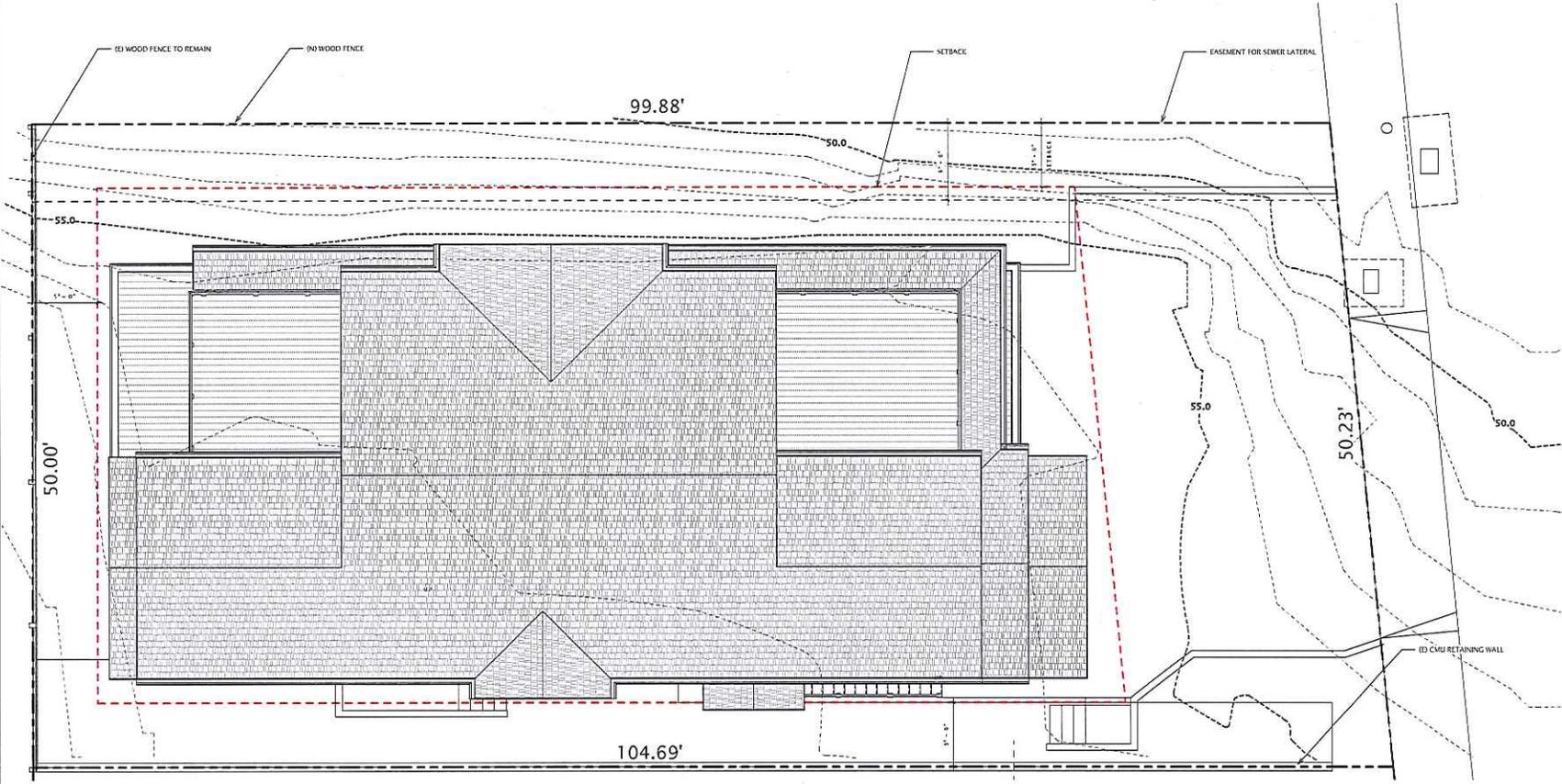



Upper Level Floor Plan




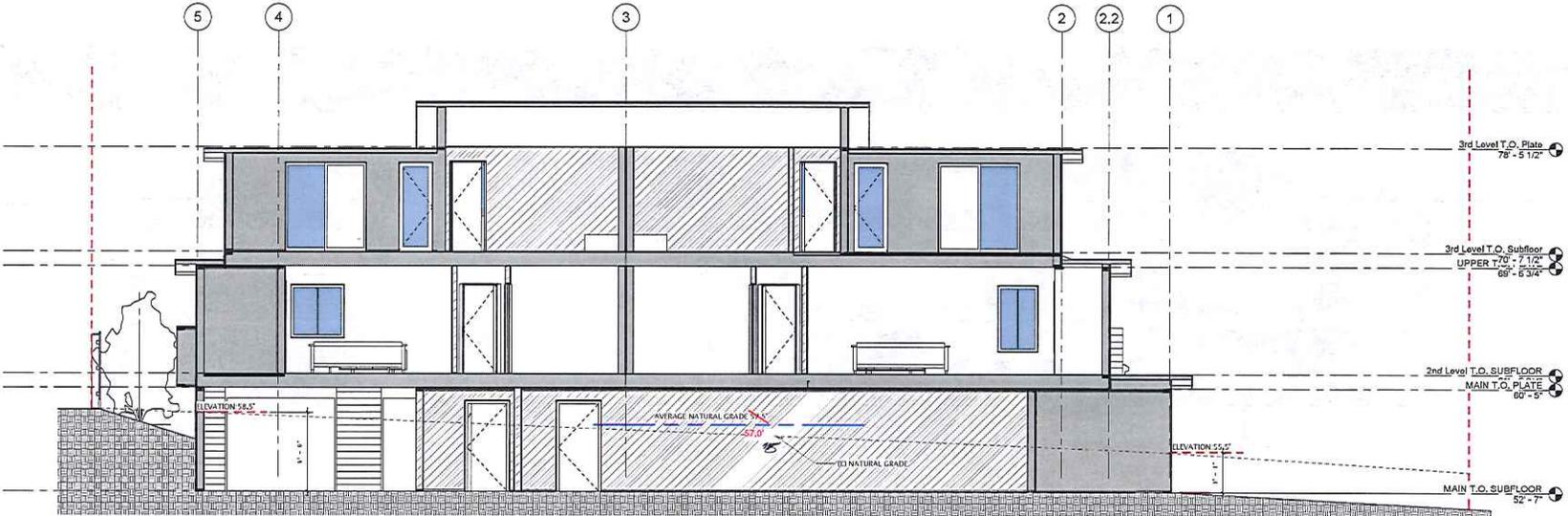

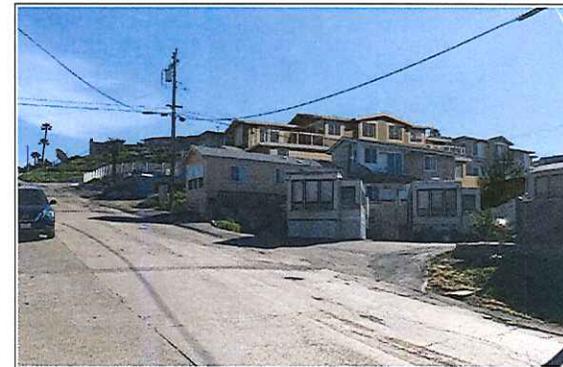

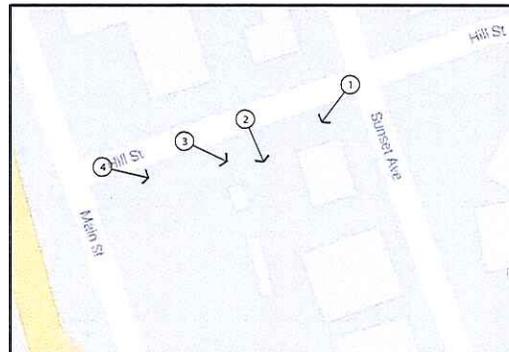
