Question 2:

I bring to this committee a very unique combination of public service, private business experience, and a cultural attachment to this region that will serve our community well in Morro Bay.

I began my interest in public service when I was just out of college by being elected to the Fresno City Council at the age of 26 in a city of just under 500,000 people and overseeing a budget of \$750M. While serving, I served on many boards and commissions including the Fresno County Transportation Authority as well as the both the Employee Retirement System and Fire & Police Retirement System.

I later went on to pursue my Masters in Public Administration at the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University where I focused my education on Business/Government relations as well as immigration and housing.

After over 15 years of work as a professional civil engineer, I decided to take my understanding of both business and government and begin an engineering and construction firm that has been able to do work for the U.S. Department of Defense as well as the U.S. Fish and Wildlife.

Most recently I have been extremely active in my tribal community as a member of the tribal council for the Salinan Tribe of San Luis Obispo and Monterey Counties. Giving back to my indigenous culture that is the most socially and economically disadvantaged group in the United States has been a true honor. I see my life as being a role model for so many that have been left behind as so much has been taken away from all of us for the last 250 years in California. Unfortunately, this still continues to this very day.

With this experience, I feel I can bring a very good public policy, business, and social view to our budgetary needs for the people of Morro Bay.

Question 3:

When you wake up everyday and come from a long family history that was fundamentally instrumental in building the central coast, as well as the Pierce family that started the abalone and fishing industry in Morro Bay, you live with a keen sense of responsibility to this region. Simply put, this is all about giving to a community in a way that my family has for hundreds of years.


