Mayor Headding called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. with all but Council Member Addis present. Council Member Addis joined the meeting at 3:33 p.m.

CLOSED SESSION PUBLIC COMMENT – Mayor Headding opened public comment for items on the agenda.

T. Mastro spoke regarding the proposed bike connector trail being considered along Toro Lane and suggested an alternate route along the east side of Highway 1 be considered.

Karl Levy, President of North Point Morro Bay Homeowners' Association, submitted written comments and spoke on behalf of the 10 property owners on Toro Lane, expressing opposition to the plan to use Toro Lane for the connector trail.

Jim Shuler, Toro Lane property owner and former HOA President, expressed safety concerns and questioned the County and City's legal right to develop a connector trail along Toro Lane.

The public comment period was closed.

The City Council moved to Closed Session and heard the following items:
