I don't have any strong opinions about the new red curb location on Yerba Buena but I have something you should consider before making your decision.

Before adding new red curbs in town, you should make sure that the existing red curbs are working and maintained. I am specifically referring to the No Parking/Bike Lane from roughly Atascadero Road to Spencer's Market. That curb is badly faded and chipped and often ignored. Several cars and trucks park there regularly and never get ticketed. It is a hazard for cyclists. If you are going to expand the amount of red curbs you need to make sure the existing ones get maintained first.
