



Statement of Background/Interests

My wife and I are residents of Morro Bay and property owners since 2001, after living four years in Los Osos. We came here from almost 20 years on the upper Chesapeake Bay, and I cherish our local coastal environment as I did that one. We have two adult children, who both graduated from Morro Bay High School. We have a fleet of two kayaks and a pack of two dogs.

I remain a registered architect in the State of Maryland, and have been since 1984. I practiced for almost 20 years in Baltimore and the Chesapeake Bay region, and the east coast, from Cape May in New Jersey to the Outer Banks in North Carolina, initially with firms specializing in sensitive renovation in 18th and 19th century historic urban neighborhoods, and later with civic, and K-12 and collegiate buildings. These firms received six AIA awards for that work where I was Project Designer and Manager. I currently limit my efforts to residential design and design consultation to non-profits, most recently the completion of the 1940's era relocated military chapel that is St. Benedict's Church in Los Osos, and their Master Plan for 2017-37.

Since coming to the Central Coast in 1997, I have been employed at Cal Poly, where I am Professor of Architecture, and currently the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs for the College of Architecture and Environmental Design. I taught the yearlong undergraduate thesis in architecture for eleven years, and was then asked to draw up a new curriculum for the Beginning Design area in 2009 that I led through 2013. For that work I have been the recipient of the university Distinguished Teacher Award, the architecture department's Faculty Merit Award, and was recently named one of '25 Most Admired Educators, 2016' by Design Intelligence magazine.

My academic research is in an area of philosophy termed *speculative realism*, which affects a myriad of topics from my teaching pedagogy to understanding the threshold of cultural practices and spatial identification, as well as influencing my writing in environmental aesthetics and ethics. This work has been presented and published internationally in philosophic, educational, and architectural conference venues.

I began interests in local planning issues in the city with my participation in the North Embarcadero Waterfront Futures Task Force [NEW Futures] in 2006-07, which looked at the future of the power plant site. I am on current term on the Planning Commission 2013-17 and in 2007-2011. I believe an important task of local government is the responsible dialogue necessary for the planning of what are the collective aspects of community- the infrastructure, roads, parks, open space, density and mix of uses. These aspects transcend the lives of many of us, and so our work is also an intergenerational compact with future citizens while respecting the economic and environmental opportunities and impacts on current citizens. Morro Bay has a unique character and a fantastic ecology and it is important to respect all those who are part of these realities as we open the still latent opportunities for the future.

Background and Interests

As noted in the attached curriculum vitae, I do have considerable previous experience in land use planning, including sixteen years of service with the Airport Land Use Commission of San Luis Obispo County and six years of experience with the Morro Bay Planning Commission. In addition, my on-going activities as a reviewer of medical research manuscripts gives me a somewhat unique perspective on the critical evaluation of statistical information and has proven useful in the interpretation of background data which will serve as the basis for future economic planning and for the City's General Plan revision.

I am interested in continuing to serve as a member of the Planning Commission, first and foremost, because I believe that the current Commission is a dedicated, well-informed, and balanced group which will approach the important challenges facing our community without bias or preconceived agendas, but with an earnest effort to assist the Council in implementing solutions that are optimal for all of Morro Bay's residents. Participating in this process with Commissioners Lucas, Luhr, Sadowski, and Ingrassia has been a deeply rewarding experience, and I believe I can be a productive contributor to this group as we move forward.

Morro Bay is, today, facing a number of major challenges and opportunities. Among these are:

- Climate change, which is likely to bring rising sea levels and continuing issues related to water availability
- Aging infrastructure, both public and private
- Housing affordability for local residents
- Potential re-purposing of significant land areas within and adjacent to the City - including Dynergy site, Atascadero Road area, and Chevron properties.

While these are daunting issues, addressing them sooner, rather than later, is vital. The extent to which we engage these concerns pro-actively, thoughtfully, and with full community involvement will determine whether we can, in the future, maintain the quality of life for residents, the unique community character that we all treasure, and the City's fiscal sustainability.

Some specific areas in which I am currently involved include:

- Plan Morro Bay - Revision of the City's General Plan/Local Coastal Plan and Zoning Ordinance
- Revision of the City's Sign Ordinance
- Introducing a reasonable program of code enforcement that is consistent with current community opinion and priorities.

If the City Council is supportive of this vision and of these current efforts, I would appreciate your appointment to an additional term of service on the Planning Commission.
