Groundwater Monitoring Well Destruction Starts on July 20, 2020

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is providing oversight for the investigation and management of historic environmental impacts at the Morro Bay Power Plant located at 1290 Embarcadero (Site). PG&E previously owned and operated the power plant from 1955 to 1998. Today, Dynegy owns the plant, which closed in 2014.

PG&E will be destroying groundwater monitoring wells at the Site that DTSC has determined are no longer needed. Please note that these wells are associated with the historical investigations, not with the proposed remedy currently going through the public comment process for the Site. Work will include:

- Destroying 22 groundwater monitoring wells throughout the site (see map on back) by over-drilling wells using a drill rig and/or filling well locations with cement, in accordance with local permits
- Finishing the surfaces of the well locations with native soil or concrete to match the surrounding conditions

Work will begin on July 20, 2020 and last for approximately two weeks. All work will be conducted during the hours of **7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.**

All work will be conducted onSite and we do not anticipate any significant impacts to the community. You may hear some minor noise from drilling activities. Work will be performed according to a Site-Specific Health and Safety Plan that includes measures to minimize potential dust, noise and other impacts.
