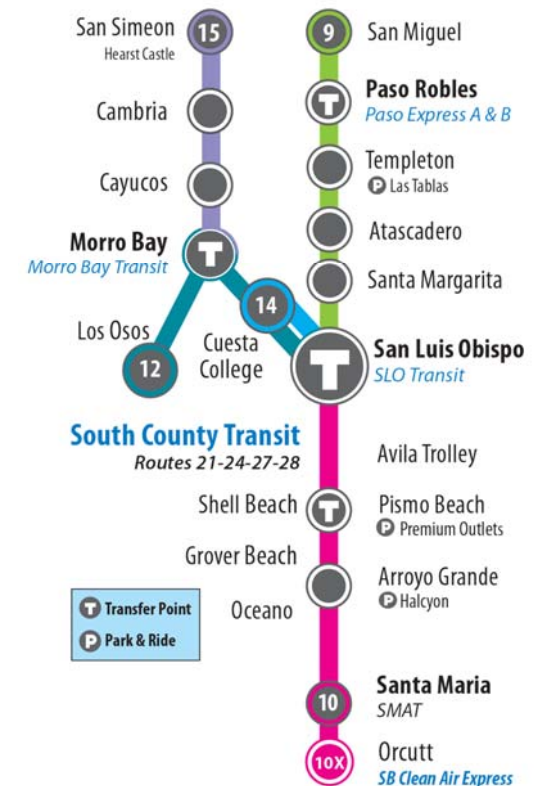

Veterans Express Shuttle

- For veterans from home to San Luis Obispo or Santa Maria veteran's clinics; door-to-door service.

Medical Shuttle

- CenCal or Medi-Cal insurance pays for trip
- Medical appointment shuttle service to and from the doctor's office or hospital anywhere in SLO County.

Transit Connections

Morro Bay Transit connects with RTA Routes 12 and 15 at City Park. During the trolley season, the RTA connects with the trolley at City Park and Morro Bay Transit connects with trolley routes at City Park and at the Centennial Stairway on Market Street.

Rules for a Safe Ride

- No smoking, eating or drinking (except from spill-proof container).
- No loud music or cell phone conversations.
- No standing or sitting in the step wells.
- Front seats are reserved for seniors and passengers with disabilities.
- Due to limited space, bag limit of 2 paper or 3 plastic bags per rider.
- No animals on the bus.
- Do not disturb the driver or passengers.
- Carry-on items (including folded strollers) must be held or secured to protect other passengers in case of sudden stop and must not block the aisle or exits.
- No graffiti, alcohol, drugs or weapons.
- Remain in your seat and belted until bus comes to a complete stop.

Bicycle Racks

The bus is equipped with a bicycle rack for your use. Space is on a first come, first served basis. Passengers are responsible for both loading and unloading the bicycle from the rack.

Please signal to the driver that you will be loading your bicycle. Also, when exiting the bus, remind the driver that you will be unloading your bicycle from the rack.

The City is not responsible for bicycles left on or for damages arising from bicycles not properly affixed to the rack.

No bicycles will be allowed inside the bus.

Call-A-Ride ~ 1-805-772-2744

Call-A-Ride curb-to-curb service is available to everyone. The fixed route bus will deviate off route up to 3/4 of a mile to pick up/drop off rider, then return on route before the next scheduled stop.

Be ready when the bus arrives by being out at the curb at your scheduled pick up time.

Call between 8-10 AM., Monday through Friday, to schedule a ride for the next day. Monday trips need to be scheduled on the Friday before.

No pets are allowed on bus.

Fare Information

Fare is on a per ride basis and to be paid at time of ride (cash or pass). No cash on delivery will be accepted.

PLEASE CARRY EXACT FARE. DRIVERS DO NOT MAKE CHANGE.

- Fixed Route - \$1.50
- Discount Fixed Route* - 0.75
- Call-A-Ride - \$2.50

Free Fare: Children under 5 years old with a fare paying adult (limit 2).

Pass Information

- Day Pass:
 - Fixed Route - \$4
 - Discount Fixed Route* - \$2
- Punch Pass: 11 rides
 - Fixed Route - \$15.00
 - Discount Fixed Route* - \$7.50
 - Call-A-Ride - \$25

Morro Bay Transit passes can be purchased from the driver.

The Fixed Route accepts **validated** Regional 31 Day and Day Passes. An RTA driver can validate your pass.
