MORRO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (formed 4/22/25)

The purpose of the Morro Elementary School Subcommittee is to unite the community and City efforts for the accomplishment of the City Council goal to acquire the Morro Elementary School site and/or work with a developer on this project. To this end, two council members are appointed to facilitate communication and cooperation between the citizen's group, Friends of Morro Elementary, and the Community Development Director regarding applicable State law, potential financial resources, and the San Luis Coastal Unified School District. The City Council as a whole will be kept up to date weekly, if not more frequently, as events unfold. This subcommittee's work is complete when an agreement is signed between the School District and the City; or it is determined that acquisition is beyond the City's reach. At either conclusion, the City Council will revisit whether the subcommittee has a related purpose or should be terminated.

SHARED FIRE SERVICES SUBCOMMITTEE (formed 11/12/25)

The Shared Fire Services subcommittee is created for the purpose of determining the scope of a shared services agreement with Los Osos Community Services District (LOCSD).

- Parameters: Under the City Council's collective policy direction, the Subcommittee will collaborate with staff in identifying opportunities and exploring options for shared services for fire and emergency medical responses which may include hiring of personnel, providing emergency response, Fire Marshal services, and Emergency Operations Center coverage. The subcommittee is expected to research pertinent topics, engage with the community and share information with the Council, staff and the community.
- Duration: The Subcommittee will function for the duration necessary to enable the Council to decide on the scope of the response to the letter of Interest received and negotiation of an agreement if both agencies determine the proposal is feasible.
