**SLURRY NOTICE**

This Notice is intended to provide context and clarification for the upcoming slurry seal work scheduled throughout the city. It accompanies [schedule](#), which outlines the planned dates and locations for work. Please be advised that while we do not currently anticipate any changes, this schedule is subject to change. If any adjustments are necessary, an updated notice and schedule will be distributed to affected areas **at least four (4) days in advance** of the new work dates.

The slurry seal contractor will deliver a detailed notice (see attached sample) to each impacted property. The schedule will be printed on the back of the notice. Please read both the notice and the schedule carefully to understand when and how your area will be affected.

We want to draw special attention to the **Downtown District** slurry work, which includes key streets such as **Embarcadero, Pacific, Beach, Harbor, and Main**, among others. These areas experience high levels of pedestrian and vehicle activity, so temporary closures will have a greater impact.

**Important Note on Street Access During Slurry Work:**

When a street is being slurried, **pedestrian access across the street will not be allowed** until the road has fully reopened to vehicle traffic. This is a critical safety requirement and will be strictly enforced.

To help illustrate this, here is an example from the schedule:

- On **Wednesday, April 23**, slurry work is planned for:
  - **Embarcadero, from Harbor to Marina:** The **northbound lane** will be **closed**.
  - **Harbor, from Embarcadero to Main:** This section will have a **full closure**.

During this time:

- Vehicles **will be allowed to drive southbound** on Embarcadero.
- **Pedestrian traffic and any vehicle access crossing slurry will be strictly prohibited** until the area has been reopened. This may require walking around the section of roadway that is getting slurried, just to get to the other side of the road.

Please plan ahead for alternate routes and allow for extra time when navigating through these areas.
